The Itsio Islands are as delicate as its neighbours. Essentially made of the Quatre Freres (four brothers), they host the nesting grounds and shelters of thousands of species of birds.

The private, white-sand beach of Tsarabanjina is located in the Mitsio islands archipelago. It is owned by the Constance Hotels and welcomes tourists throughout the year.

Exploring the places that make its fame, such as Hell-Ville (the capital), the ylang-ylang cultures, and its luxurious hotels, the film presents the radiant Nosy Be in its Indian Ocean. We will discover the richness of this paradise through the people who live on the island and make it thrive.
